PLEASE READ.

There has been some misunderstanding about shipment by Freight when the Grange Seal is affixed to the order. We only ship by Freight *when requested*, (see page two).

If sample heading for your order is followed (see page four), there will never be any mistakes of this nature.

The new postal law allows goods sent by Mail to the extent of four pounds, at one cent for every ounce. This is a quick means of shipping light goods, but not always the most economical.

In all shipments made by Mail, we require money in advance sufficient to pay for goods and the postage on the same. As we can get no receipt from the Post Office Department, we will not be responsible for any loss from miscarriage. If you send too much money we will return the change.


All orders received after this date, taken from Catalogues 11 or 12, will be filled from Catalogue No. 13, the advantage in price being largely in favor of the purchaser.

Our intention is to get out new Catalogues from three to four times a year, according to the state of the market.


It is best to make your orders exceed five dollars, unless your order is for a class of goods that will afford you a profit after adding charges.

CIRCULAR.

In offering you this (our 13th) Catalogue, we feel called upon to thank our friends for their kind support.

We have now, in consequence of liberal patronage, reduced our prices on every article where there was any chance to do so (as you will find by comparing), and have added largely to our list.

You will find full instructions regarding the manner of making out your orders, etc., on the succeeding pages, which *we desire you will follow*, and thus avoid, as nearly as possible, all delays, errors and misunderstandings.

The original plan of conducting our business, suggested by the growing combination of farmers to deal directly with a house near the base of supplies, was to ship goods by Express, collect on delivery (*i. e.* C. O. D.) only; but as time passed and strangers became friends, the necessity of reducing the expenses of transportation became apparent, and we allowed goods to go by Freight to Granges, when the Grange seal was affixed to the order. We now announce

THE FOLLOWING RULES, WHICH GOVERN OUR TRADE :

We furnish Catalogues to any one upon application. The Secretary of a Grange can order enough for the whole Grange. Say how many you want.

We furnish samples of all piece goods upon application, but require you to enclose ten cents to assist in defraying the expenses of this department, and as an earnest that you are desirous of trading with us if we can offer sufficient inducements. When samples of other goods are sent for with orders, you need not enclose the ten cents.

All samples have numbers attached to correspond with numbers on Catalogue.

Our regular way is to ship C. O. D. by Express, subject to examination before any money is paid out. If the goods are right, you pay all charges and the amount of the bill to the Express Agent, who is responsible to us for the goods or the money. *If requested*, we will ship by Freight when the Grange seal is affixed to the order and signed by the Master or Secretary of the Grange. Any one unable to procure the Grange Seal and desiring goods shipped by Freight, can send money with the order sufficient to meet all the cost of goods and expenses of case and cartage. The two last items amount to from 25 cents to \$1.50, according to size of package and distance to haul. If you send too much, we will return the change; if not enough, we shall leave out some article. *In all other cases*, the goods go C. O. D. by Express (we cannot ship C. O. D. by Freight). As we ship by Freight to make the expense of transportation come less to the consignee, we make it a part of the contract that payment shall be made to us just as soon as the goods are at hand and examined.

This being an affair of honor, and a place wherein we put our trust in the honesty of the Patron, we hope we shall never be called upon to refuse shipment in this way because of the risk of non-payment. We take pleasure in saying here that all payments on goods have been made up to this date, although we regret that our friends are sometimes a little slow about it. We here notify all Granges with whom we have dealings that we keep a *black list*, and unless remittances are made without unnecessary delay, we shall be obliged to place them on this list as being too slow, and refuse to ship them goods.

The following Advice to Express Agents is sent with each Collection.

You are hereby requested to allow the Consignee or Agent to examine—if they so desire—all packages sent by our House for Delivery and Collection at your station. If they refuse to take the goods, *immediately notify us*, and we will order the disposal of them.

By order of the Express Companies, we can allow only the individual to whom the goods are shipped to examine the goods at the Express Office. This is a privilege that should not be abused. Consider that the Agent has no interest in the matter, and is responsible to us for the goods or the money. Do not detain him too long nor scatter the goods.

We are continually receiving orders and letters with some important item of the address left off. Sometimes no name is signed; again, the post-office address is left out, or the State is not mentioned. To avoid all such errors, we ask you to commence your letters as per sample given on page 4, substituting your own name, address, and how to be shipped—by Freight or Express—always remembering, we do not ship by Freight unless the order is signed by the Master or Secretary, and has the Grange seal affixed. If you have no *seal*, order one of S. D. Childs, Jr., & Co. (See their advertisement on page 69 of this book). If your orders have not the Grange seal affixed, we will positively ship C O. D. by Express.

Order as much of anything as you wish, and you will be charged only in proportion to our quotations. We will furnish blank orders with printed instructions, etc., free of charge, upon application.

In writing your name and address, do not endeavor to show us a sample of spread-eagle, but rather affect the simple, plain and perfectly legible signature of *John Hancock*. After giving us your order, if you have anything to say that will require an answer, write it on a separate sheet of paper with Post Office address, etc. Your order will go to the Order Desk and your letter to the Correspondence Desk, and both receive attention. In referring to any previous transaction, give dates of letters and number of invoice.

We cheerfully answer all inquiries relating to any class of merchandise, but before you ask, see that your questions are not answered in this Catalogue.

We make the usual jobbers' charges for cases and cartage where goods are shipped by Freight, and for cases only when shipped by Express. All goods by Freight must be packed in cases or trunks; goods by Express we use no cases unless we are so obliged to insure the safety of contents.

We give quotations or goods in our House ; hence all expenses of transportation and remittance must be paid by the purchaser. No Draft or Check on a Country Bank is par here. On Freight bills remit in Currency by Express—charges prepaid. By Post Office Order, or buy a Draft of your banker on either Chicago, New York, or Boston, and send us by mail.

No Agents Wanted! No Commissions Paid!! We are continually besieged by our friends who get up clubs for us, for presents. *This is wrong.* We sell our goods at the lowest possible percentage, and if we pay commissions, *we must add it to the prices of the goods.* We take it that clubs are gotten up for your own mutual benefit, to reduce expense of transportation. We had as soon ship to separate individuals. We therefore decline to pay commissions or employ agents—on the Grand Grange principle, "Do away with the middlemen as far as possible."

Our old friends will not ask for testimonials, but for those to whom we are strangers, we beg to call attention to a limited number, to be found in the back of this catalogue. As you will notice, none of the original letters of commendation were solicited ; all were voluntary; and, as we were in honor bound not to publish them without permission of the writer, we wrote for them and publish both the original and their letters of permission.

GROCERIES.

We do not send Price Lists of Groceries or keep a large stock on hand. We did intend to add a full line of this class of merchandise to our stock, but for reasons partly explained herein we have concluded not to engage in the Grocery trade. With the view of going into the trade, we perfected our arrangements for the purchase of Groceries and kindred goods on exceedingly favorable terms, and will, for the accommodation of our customers, fill all orders sent us, at prices only sufficient to remunerate us for the expense in handling, subject to the following conditions :

We do not think it advisable to ship heavy groceries by express, such as Sugar, Rice, Green Coffee, Soap, etc. ; they are staple articles, sold by all dealers, for a mere nominal profit, and they add to the cost of transportation to an alarming degree. To illustrate : suppose you order dry goods, etc., to the value of \$20, approximate weight fifteen pounds ; you then order fifteen pounds soap, sent with the dry goods, value \$1.25, the cost of transportation will be almost as much on \$1.25 worth of soap as on \$20 worth of dry goods. Hence you will see that our legitimate business is damaged, as you will naturally average the cost on the total amount of the bill.

When the requirements for shipment by freight are complied with, and goods are ordered shipped in that way, we have no further objections to offer, but will ship groceries heavy as lead if requested.

Teas and Spices can be sent by *Express*, with perfect satisfaction to all concerned, as with our system of prices you will be able to make a large saving on this class of goods.

We will purchase *all kinds* of merchandise not quoted by us at a commission of 5 per cent. above cost.

In many places we shall not be able, by *argument*, to bring about a practical reform and convince the trading class of the truth of our position; but shall, in our attempt to inaugurate a better system, be compelled to apply the convincing argument of ordering supplies, for a time, where we can obtain them at wholesale rates for cash.

I have written you as I could get a spare moment while on the wing, well knowing that the work accumulating during my absence would require my undivided attention when I reached it; and to any correspondent who reads the *Granger*, this letter will explain my apparent neglect.

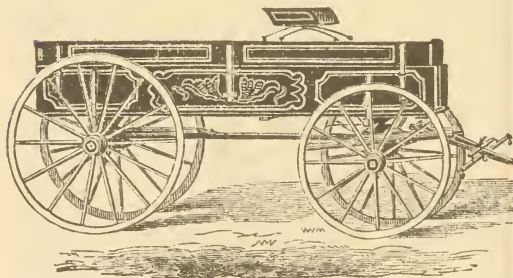

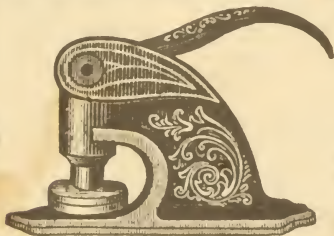
