





HOW TO LAY OUT A FOOT BALL FIELD

The following diagram and rules for laying out a foot ball field are reproduced from Spaldimen in the various training camps who may not have a co ng's Official Foot Ball Guide and will be found useful to

The Field of Play is a Parallelogram bounded by the side lines and goal lines and thus measuring 300 feet by 160 feet.

Section 2. Field of Play is a Paraueiogram bounded by the side lines and goal lines and thus measuring 300 feet by 100 feet.

Section 1. Field—The game shall be played upon a rectangular field, 300 feet in length and 160 feet in width. The lines at the ends of the field shall be termed End Lines. Those at the sides shall be termed Side Lines and shall extend indefinitely beyond their points of intersection with the goal lines. The Goal Lines shall be termed Side Lines shall be termed by the goal lines and the side lines shall be termed the Field of Play. The spaces bounded by the goal lines and the side lines shall be termed the Field of Play. The spaces bounded by the goal lines, the end lines and the side lines shall be termed the End Zones.

Section 2. These lines shall be marked in white. The Field of Play shall be marked at intervals of five yards with white lines parallel to the goal lines.

NOTE—Previous to the beginning of play, the Referee shall see that the field is properly marked.

Section 3. The goal posts shall be placed in the middle of each goal line, shall exceed 20 feet in height and be placed 18 feet 6 inches apart, with a horizontal cross-bar 10 feet from the ground.

Hole No. 2 is 354 yards in length; your first shot strikes in the left center pocket, or 180 yards in one stroke. This leaves you attempt to play a mid iron in the top center pocket, the ball strikes the top left hand pocket, giving you a total of 325 yards. It is now necessary to play a mashie shot into the pockets marked 4 feet, 9 feet and 15 feet putt, to determine how far from the hole you stand to putt. The No. Indoor Net is played the same as the No. 1, except that you play the mashie to determine how far you stand away to putt within 60 yards instead of 120, as on the No. 1 net.


First, hang the back driving canvas by ropes from the ceiling, leaving about three inches lying on the floor. There should be at least one and one-half feet between the driving canvas and the back wall, and at least two feet away from the side walls; if there is more than one net, they should be two or three feet apart. The side and top nets are then howed to the back driving canvas and attached to the ceiling. Leave about a foot of these nets lying on the floor so that there is plenty of slack to stop a rebound of the ball. The rubber mat should be nailed on a board and then nailed to the floor about twenty-three feet from the back driving net. The cocoa mat can be used on either side for left or right hand players. Do not attach the cocoa mat to the floor. Lay Putting Carpet on the floor, tack it down, and cut a hole in the floor about three feet from the end nearest the net. Make a mixture of sand and oil, seeing that the sand is thoroughly dry. Cover the putting carpet with this mixture and it will make the best possible putting.




Figure 8 Guard Fencing Foils
