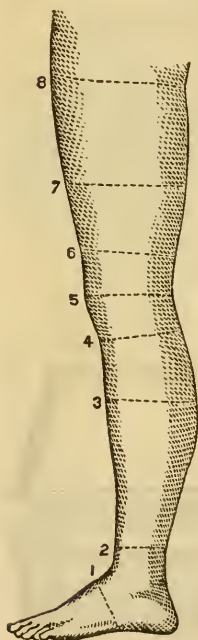
FOR WRISTLET. — Around wrist at D and E, and length from D to E.

PITCHER'S ELASTIC. — Around arm at A, B, and C, and length from A to C, at top and bottom of arm.

STOCKINGS, KNEE CAPS, ANKLETS, ETC. — Measure around the limb opposite the lines in cut. For stocking to reach from 1 to 4, give the length from heel to 4. For stocking to go above the knee, give the length from heel to 5, and from 5 to as high as wanted. Always follow the directions and be sure to give length.

*Always take measurements next to the skin.*

**PANTS.**

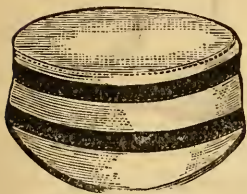
Size around waist; size around hips; length of outside seam from waist to eight inches below the knee. Or, for full-length pants, measure to the hollow of the foot, just under the instep, on both outside and inside seams. Length of inside seam from crotch to eight inches below the knee.



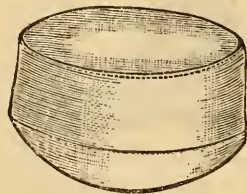
