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## PREFACE.

The designs are original, and have repeatedly been worked with great care, to prove their correctness; the illustrations have equally shared my supervision; and I humbly hope and trust that it may be as successful, and give as much satisfaction to my friends and the public, as my Croonet Boor, for which I am amply rewarded by its unprecedented success, and grateful for the many flattering testimonials received. I must here also make some observations upon the many cheap publications that have recently appeared (two of which have copied verbatim my illustrated instructions, even to a fault in the drawing), and to direct the attention of those of my readers competent to understand the many plagiarisins and general unfitness as works of instruction, of the majority, if not the wholc of those publications. I should hope, and it is needless to say, that these remarks proceed not. from the impulse of a spirit of rivalry, but from a sincere conviction that the details and instructions therein conveyed are calculated seriously to mislead, if not entirely prevent and disgust the student from acquiring a proper knowledge of these clegant and useful
employments, by their ineorrectness; that, in short, they are nothing more than very imperfect arrangements, copied from the really useful Works that have been hitherto published, and tend quite as much to injure those who publish from experience, as those who learn in order to derive instruction or add information to their previous knowledge.

## EXPLANATION OF TERMS.

TO CAST ON WITH ONE PIN.


Taks the thread, and putting it between the second and third fingers of the left hand, leave an end of about one yard for every 100 stitches; pass it round the left thumb, from left to right; then take the pin in the right hand, placing it under the erossing of the thread; put the needle down the loop, and bring the thread from the outside forward on the point of the pin; take the thread in the right hand, and passing it round the pin as A , turn the loop B on the laft thamb over the pin, and draw it tight with the end thrend in the left hand, and repent untll the required number of stitches are on the pin.

## TO CAST ON WITH TWO PINS.

This is the Spanish method, and is particularly adapted for working fine wools, by its forming a looser stiteh. Tie a loop at the end of the thread, and putit on the pin, holding it in the left hand; take the other pin with the right hand, and put it in the loop; pass the thread between the pins, and bring it forward then with the right hand pin; bring the thread through the loop on the left pin; there will now be a loop on each pin as $C$ and $D$; then pass the loop
 $D$ on to the left pin ; repeat by putting the right hand pin through the loop D , and passing the thread between the pins as before.

PLAIN KNITTING.


After casting on the stitches, hold the pin with the stitches on it in the left hand, and with the thread turned round the little finger of the right hand pass it under the second and third fingers, and over the forefinger ; take the other pin in the right hand; put this pin into the first loop on the left pin, and with the forefinger of the right hand pass the thread between the pins, bring the thread through, which forms one stiteh; then take the loop off the left pin and repcat.

## TO MAKE $\Lambda$ STITCH

liring the thread forward between the pins; when this stitch is worked in the next row it will form an open stitch.

## TO MAKE TWO. THREE, OR MORE STITCHES.

Turn the thread as many times round the pin as $\mathbf{E}, \mathrm{F}, \mathrm{G}$, and in the next row ; pearl a stitch and knit a stitch, alternately, taking off one turn of the thread each time, for as many stitches as were made in the row before.


## TOSLIPA STITCH.

To pass a stitch from the left pin to the right without working it. In all knitting the firsi stitch of every row should be slipped to make a firm and even selvedge; this is not mentioned in the receipts, as it would much lengthen the description, but is to be observed as a fixed rule; for example, when a row commences thus; knt 2 together, work'as follows :-slip the 1st stitch, knit the 2d, and turn the slipped stitch over the knitted one.

TO KNIT TWO STITCHES TOGETHER.
take two stitches with the right hand pin, and knit as 1 stitch.
TO KNIT THREE STITCHES TOGETHER.
Slip 1 stitch, knit 2 stitches together, and with the point of the left hand pin turn the slipped stitch over the 2 knitted together, leaving but 1 stitch,

PEARL, ALSO CALLED SEAM, BACK, AND RIB KNITTING.


Commence the row with the thread in front of the pin, pass the point of the pin down the stitch, turn the thread found the pin , and take it off as in plain knitting; repeat, always keeping the thread in front.

PEARL AND PLAIN STITCHES IN THE SAME HOW.
Pass the thread to the back of the work before knitting plain stitches, an $\alpha$ to the front before pearling stitches.

## TO PEARL TWO OR THREE STITCHES TOGETHER

Keep the thread in front of the pin, pass the point of the right pin down 2 or 3 stitches, and pearl them together.

TO MAKE A STITCH IN PEARL KNITTING.
Having the thread in front of the pin, turn the thread completely round the pin, so as to bring it in front again.

> TO FORM A ROUND.

4 or 5 pins are required ; cast on the required number of stitches on one pin, and divide them equally on the other 3 or 4 pins, keeping the 4th or 5th pin to knit with, and with this pin knit the 1st stitch that was cast ; on knitting off the 3 or 4 pins form one round.


## TO RAISE STITCHES.



The work must be held on the right side. Put the pin in the selvedge or side of the work, as H; pass the thread round the pin and bring it through, so as to form a stiteh of plain knitting ; repeat the same to the end.

A Kuw.
Is knitting from one and of the pin to the other.

## A PATTERN.

Is the number of rews, that are worked nefore eommeneing again.

As in the Berthe and Collan, place the two pins containing the work together, the deepest at the back, and with a third pin put it through one stitch of each pin, as I and $K$, and knit them as one stitch.


## THE STITCHES BETWEEN A PARENTHESIS ( ).

(Knit 2 together, and knit 1 three times), are worked thus, knit 2 together, knit 1; knit 2 together, knit 1; knit 2 together, knit 1; this prevents useless repetition.

When this mark (*) occurs in a row, the stitches before it are not to be repeated in the row, being merely the edge stitches to prevent the work from decreasing; thus when knit 3 together, is in a row, the row generally begins with knit 2 together and onds the same.

## TO CAST OFF.



Knit the first 2 stitches; turn the first stitch, as L, over the 2 d M; knit the $8 d$ and turn the 2 d stitch over ; repeat at the end of the row, draw the thread through and fasten off. When part of a row only is east off, as for exam-ple-cast off 30 stitehes, leaving 20 stitches ; cast off 31 stitehes, and put the last loop east off on the left pin, to make up the 20 stitches.

STITCHES OVER.
A stitch or stitches over, in many of the patterns, commeneing thus-" cast on 10 stitches for each pattern, and one over" for 7 patterns, east on 71 stitehes. As many patterns end with "make a stitch," it could not be done without this stitch to perfect the pattern.

The pins are all gauged by the Bell Gauge.

## BERTHE. CHANTILLY PATIERN.

Taylar's Crochet or Knitting Thread, No. 8 ; Pins No. 19, or Fine Block Netting Silk. This Borthe is composed of two rows of lace, with open rows between them for ribbon. In, puttern, the pearl stitch is the half of the 2 made stitches in the row before. Cast on 49 stitc: with one pin.

16th.-Same as 8th, and then knit 6 rows plain.
25th.-Same as 7th.
26th.-Same as 8 th, and then knit 6 rows plain. This finishes the 1st part of the Berthe, and leaving it on the pins, work the $2 d$ part, and when as many patterns are completed as the 1st part, raise the loops of the selvedge on the pin, pliwe the two parts together, the narrowest in front, and with a third pin knit 1 stitch off each together, and knit 2. rows plain and east off.-See "Explanation of Terms, to Join."

Taylor's Crochet or Knitting Thread, No. 12; Pins No. 21, Bell Gauge. Cast on 81 stitches with 2 pins.

1st row, pearl ; 2d row, plain ; 3 d row, pearl ; 4th row, plain ; 5th row, pearl.
6th.-Make 4, knit 3 together, knit 3 together ; repeat.
Th.-Pearl 3, knit 1, pearl 1, knit 1 ; the last 4 stitehes are those made on 6th row ; repeat. 8th, plain ; 9th, pearl; 10th, plain ; 11th, pearl.
12th-Make 1, knit 2 ; repeat.
13th.-Pearl. There will now be 121 stitehes on the pin; these 13 rows form the band, and now eommence the pattern.

Ist row.-Knit 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together ; repeat at the end of the row, knit 1.
2d.-Make 1, knit 3 together, make 1, knit 1, make 1, knit 2 together ; repeat, and end with knit 1.

36 th.-Same as 24 th ; pearling 6 instead of 18 in the corner pattern.

38th.-Pcarl and cast off; then work another piece the same, and sew one border to the wrong side of the shawl; sew that when folded both bordcrs will be on the right side.

## FRINGE FOR SHAWL.

## Double Wool. Cast on 9 stitches.

## LACE EDGING.

Tuylor's Crochct or Knitting Thrcad, No. 12; Pins No. 20. Cast on 19 stitches for each Pattern, or 1027 stitches for a yard.


1st row.-Make 1, knit 2 together ; repeat. 2d.-Plain. 3d.-Pearl 2, knit 3 togethar, knit 11, make 1, knit 2 together, make 1; knit 1, repeat.
4th.-Pcarl 14, pearl 2 together, knit 2 ; repeat.
5th.-Pearl 2, knit 3 together, knit 9, make 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 1 ; repeat.
6th.-Pearl 12, pearl 2 together, knit 2; repeat.
7th.-Pearl 2, knit 3 together, knit 7, make 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 1; repeat.
8th.-Pearl 10, pearl 2 together, knit 2; repeat.
9th.-Pearl 2, knit 3 together, knit. 5, make 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 1 ; repeat.
10th.-Pearl 8, peall 2 together, knit 2 ; repeat,
11th.-Pearl 2, knit 3 together, knit 3, make 1, knit 2 together, make 1, knit 1; repeat.
12th.-Pearl 6, pearl 2 together, knit 2; repeat.
13th.-Pearl 1, knit 3 together, knit 1, make 1, knit 3, make 1, knit 1 ; repeat.
14th.-Pearl. 15th.-Knit 3 together, make 1, knit5, make 1, knit 1; repeat. 1Gth.-Pearl

17 th.-Knit 1 *, make 1, knit 7, make 1, knit 2 together ; repeat from *, end with knit 1. 18th.-Plain.
19th.-Make 1, knit 2 together ; repent,
20th.-Plain, and east off.

## FRINGE FOR ANTI-MACASSAR.

Taylor's Mechlenburgh Thread, No. 3, or Knitting Cotton, No. 12 ; Pins No. 19. Cast ou 400 stitches for a yard. Cut a portion of the thread in pieces of 4 inches in length.
1st row.-Knit $1^{*}$, take 4 pieees of the eut thread and put them on the left pin, erossing
them so as to bring one end in the front and one at the back; then with the right hand
pin knit the loop formed by the threads, and stiteh together; then bring the ends at the
baiek forward between the pins, and knit 1 stitch; repeat from * to the end.
2nd and 3d row.-Plain.
4th.--Pearl.
5th.-Plain.
6th,-Make 1, knit 3 with the left pin, turn the 1st of the 3 knitted stitches over the other
2; repeat.
7th.-Pearl.
8th and 9th,-Plain, anl cast off.

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
