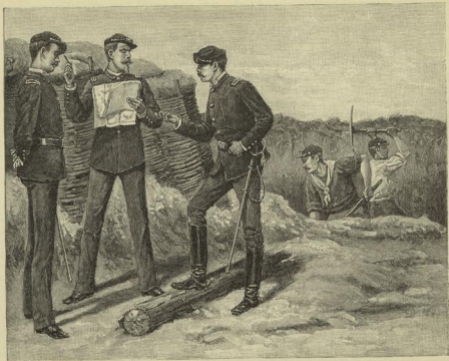

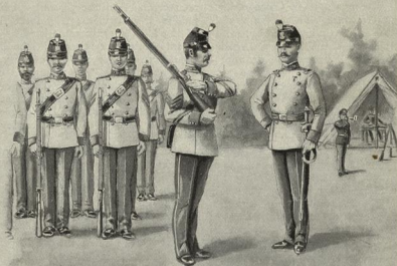

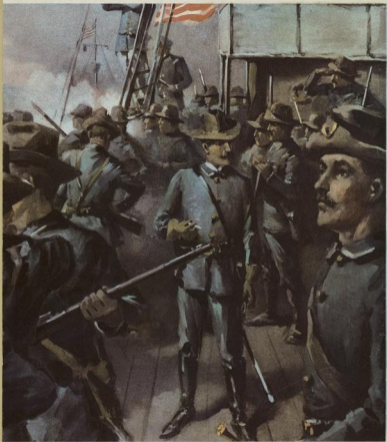

FORT SHERIDAN, ILL. GENERAL QUARTERS. REAR VIEW.

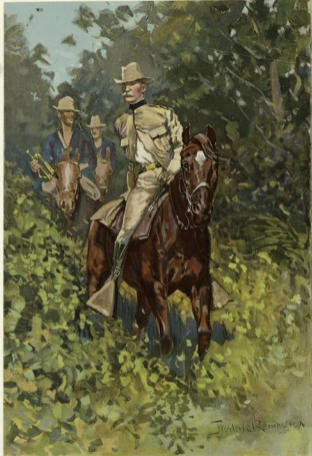

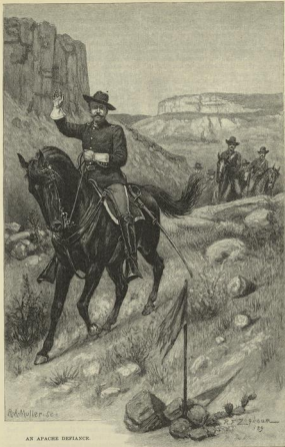

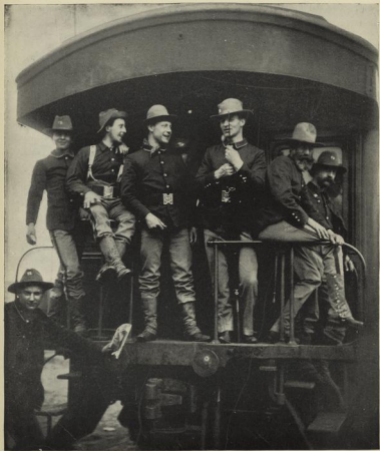
