Selecting the rating badge for the cover was no easy task for us to do. There were a number to select from as interesting.

Chief Buglemaster (1927-1948), was selected finally and it is from Dave Sullivan, who by the way was in the U.S.M.C. and is a collector of both Marine and Navy insignia and has two very handsome showdogs who win many awards at dog shows as well!!!

Dave has an impressive collection of CPO rating badges too! These include U.S.C.G. badges.

John A. Stacey's book U.S. NAVY RATING BADGES, SPECIALTY MARKS & DISTINGUISHING MARKS: 1885-1982 illustrates and describes on page 24 the Buglemaster and Bugler badges in full details. He also uses footnotes to show regulations concerning when a rate was authorized, changed, or discontinued.

Note the unusual eagle on this badge and the workmanship that went into it. Its bugle is the best made I've seen! Chevrons and arc are gold lace, and the background is navy-blue wool.

I'd suspect the tongue is red and a eye of black thread? Am unable to determine if it has bright and dead silverwire on the eagle's wings? Oftentimes dull silverwire was used with bright silverwire to highlight a rating badge. These line-made rates express pride on the wearer's part as these were made in different quality, depending on whatever they were willing to invest to really look good!

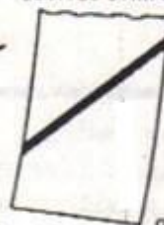

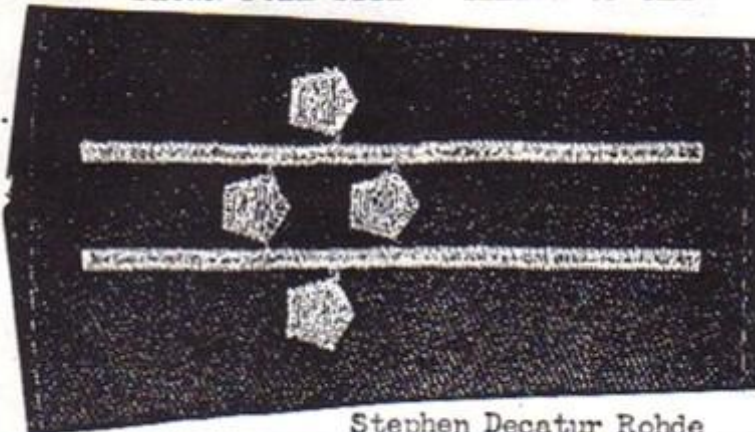

DESCRIPTION DES INSIGNES DES SOUS-MARINS:

Broche métallique ajourée comportant une rose des vents argentée, un sous-marin en métal doré, deux glaives entrecroisés à lame argentée et poignée dorée.

DESCRIPTION OF THE SUBMARINE INSIGNIA:

A metal badge with silver compass rose, gold submarine, and two crossed gold swords. This is not an exact translation, but will give the reader an idea of the badge's description and of course the two other badges have a single sword, and no sword. (BOC/PP - 1^{er} septembre 1975 - N° 35.)

The badges below are: a) Aircraft Pilot b) Aircraft Crew.

Both have a circle of silver rope with silver anchors, with gold wing(s) and a gold star.

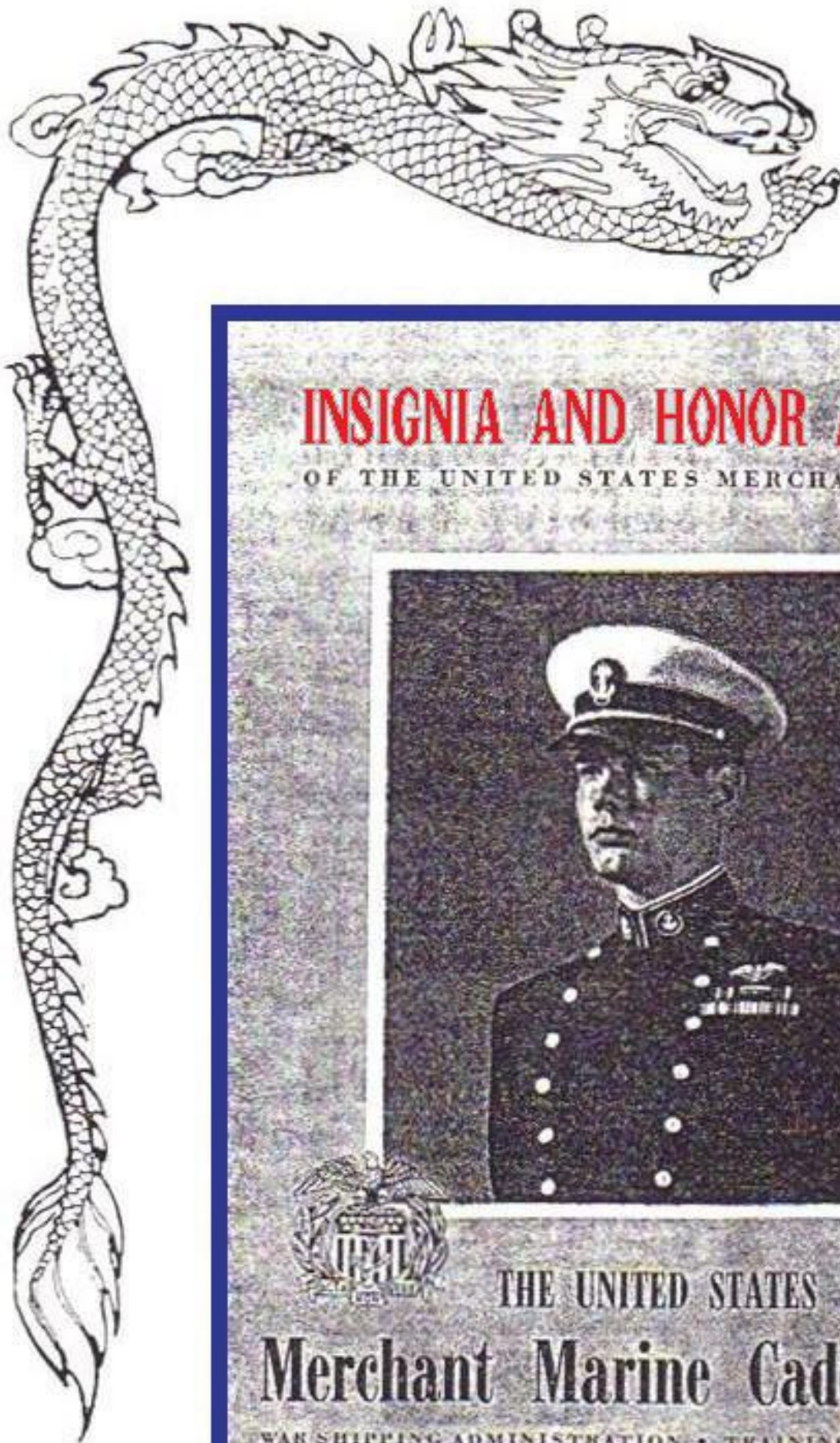

Bill said this patch has a gold rim and anchor, with white letters on blue back ground, can anyone I.D.?



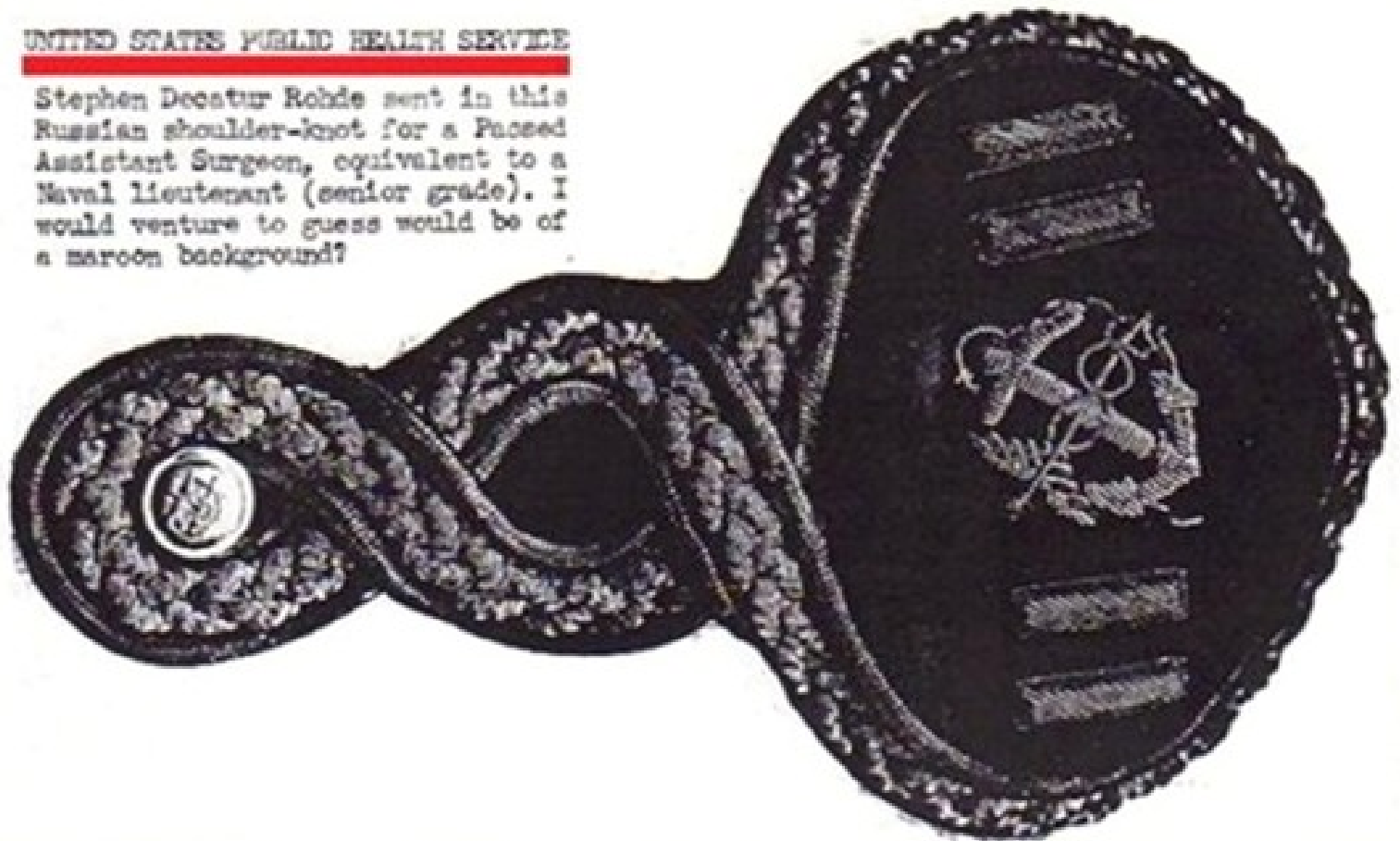
NEDERLANDSCH-INDIË

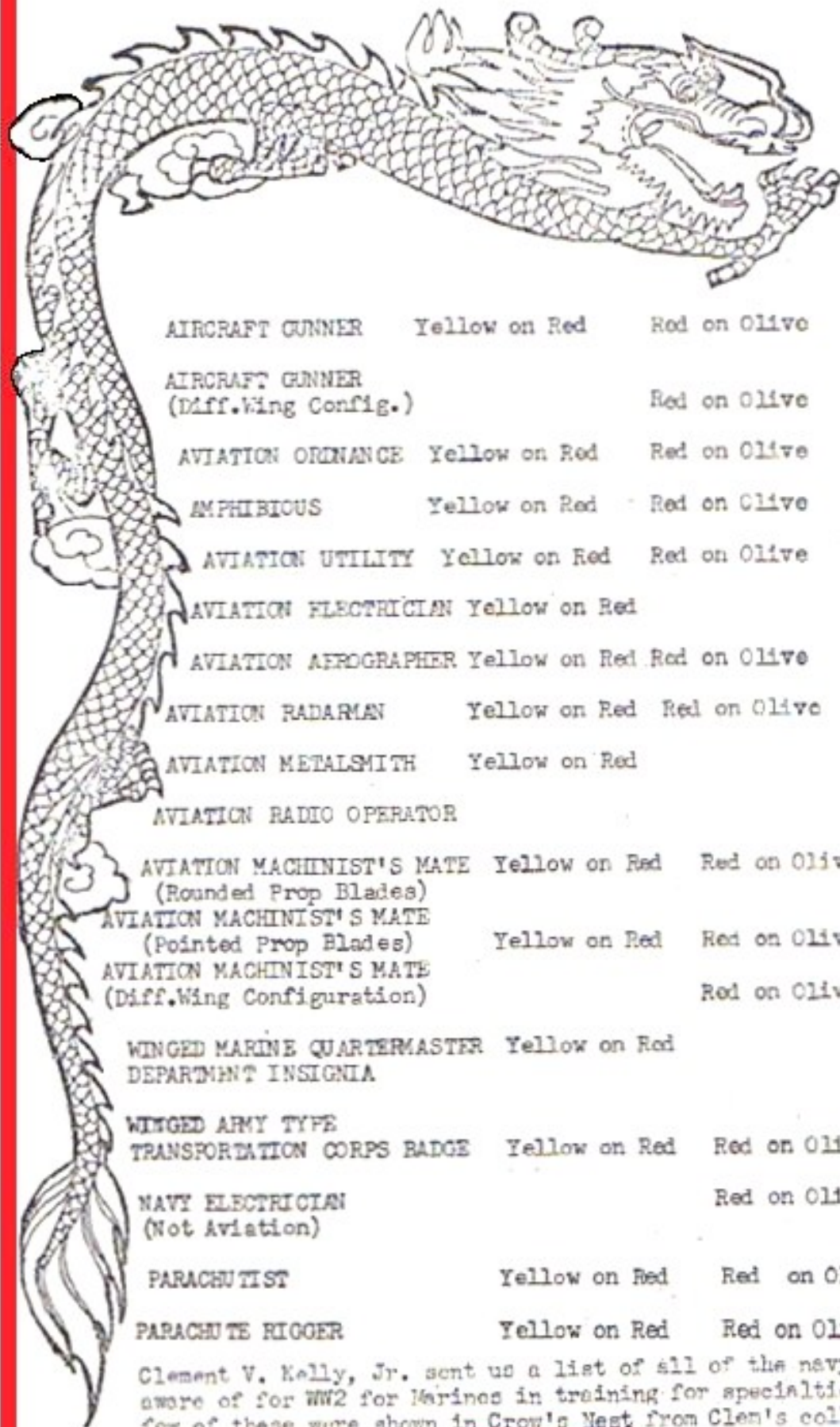
