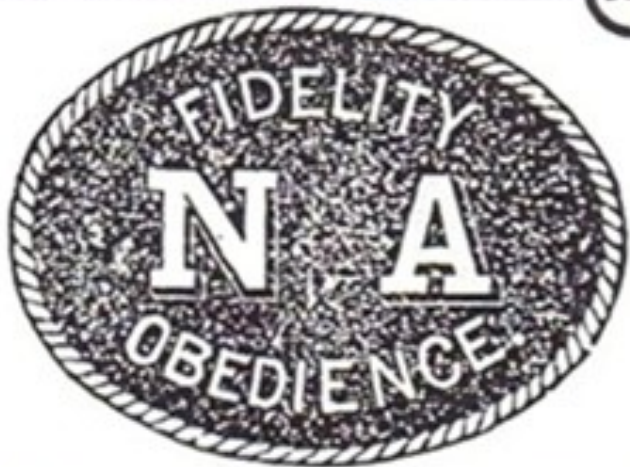

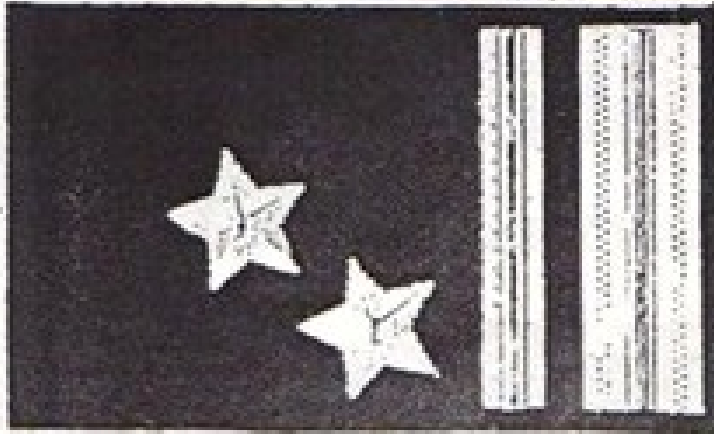

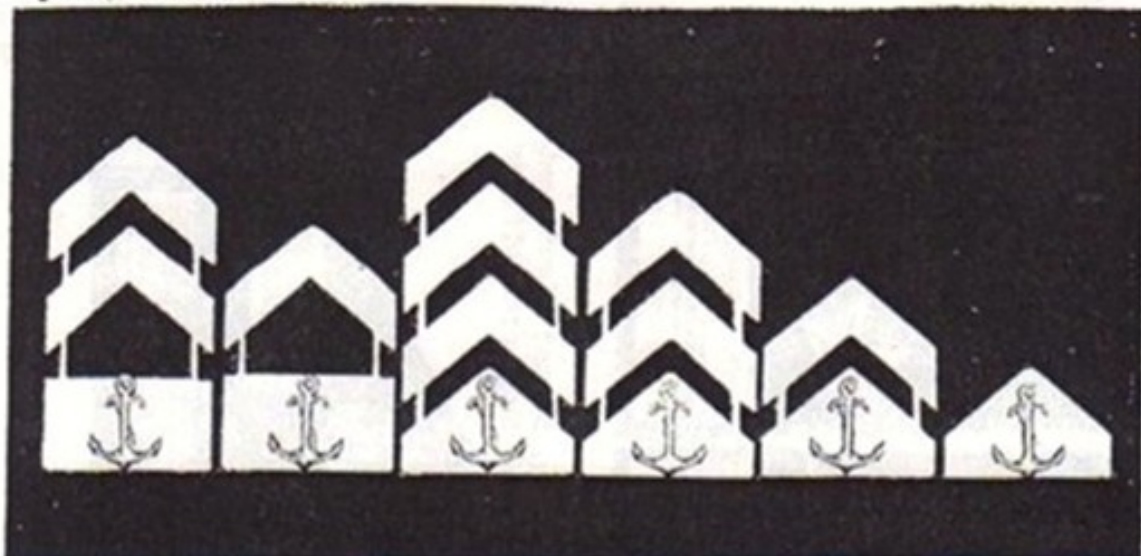

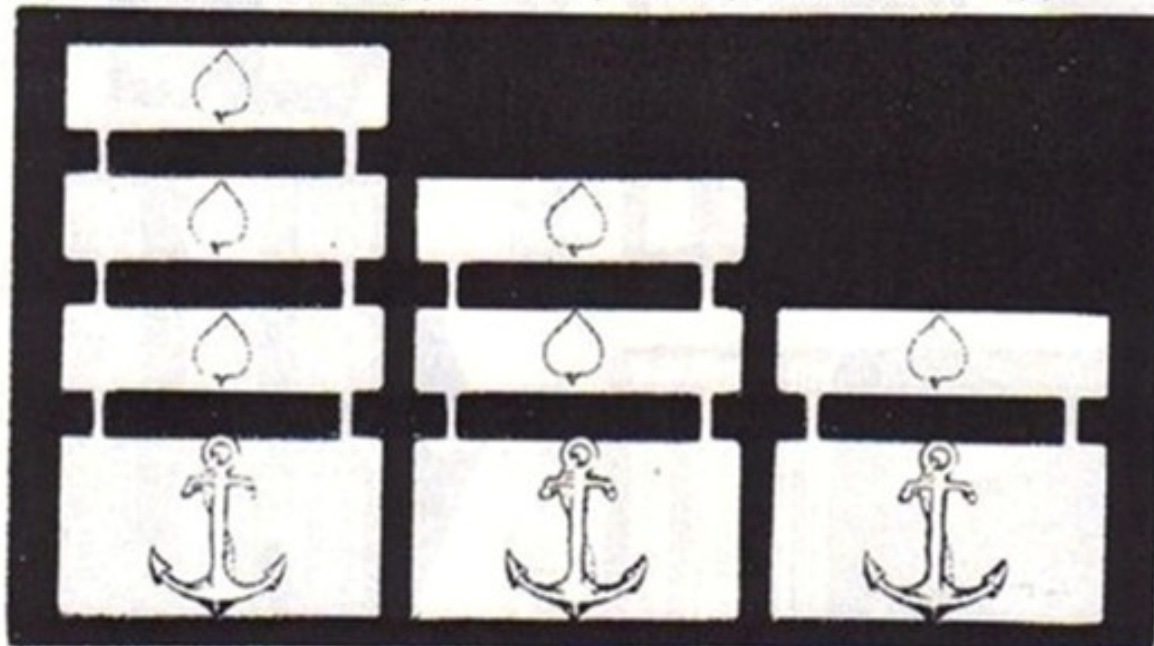

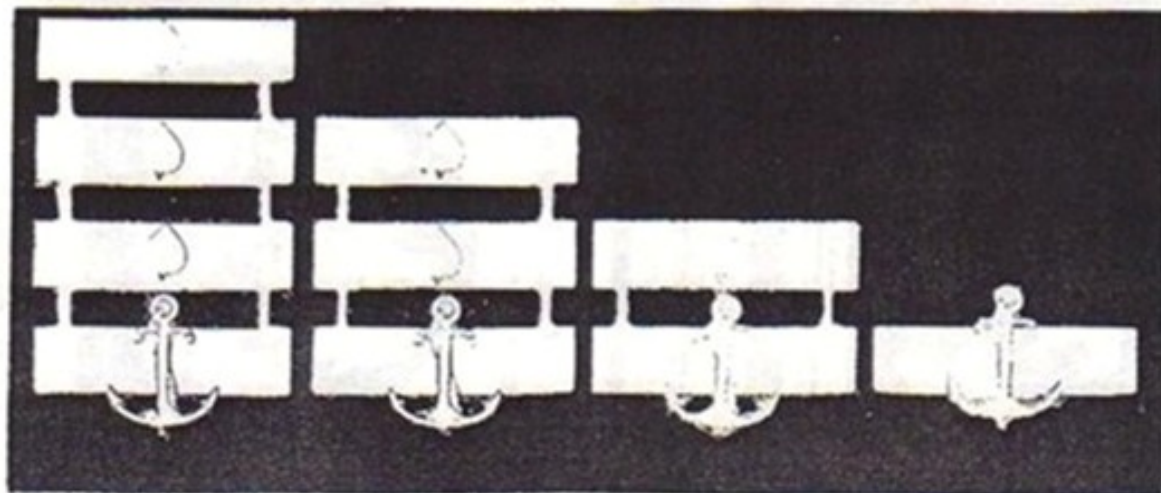

| Nonofficer member | " " " " " " " " |

(Past flag officers wear the stripes of their former office but not the stars.)

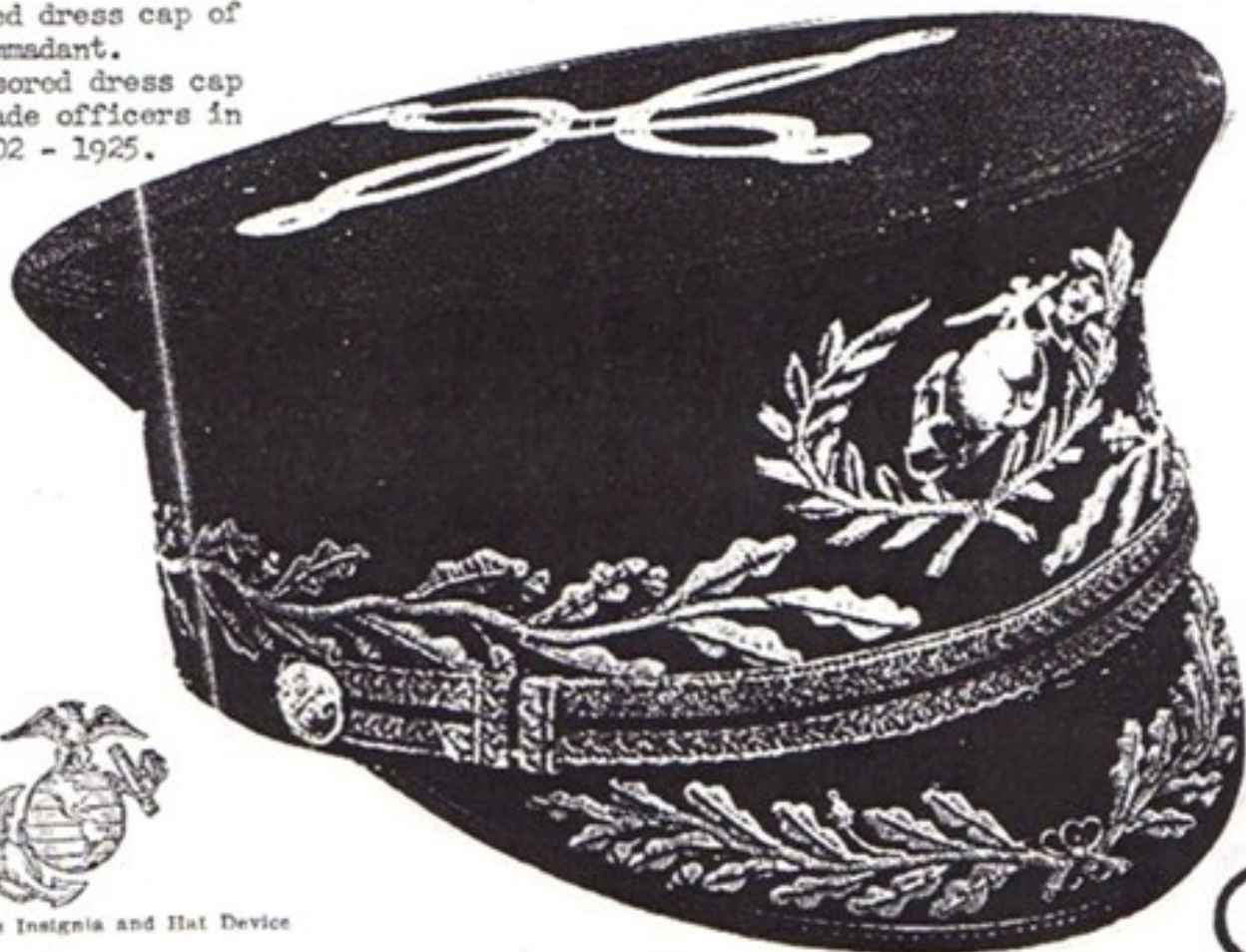

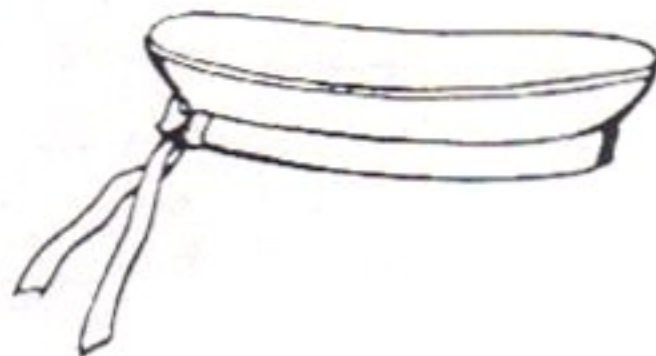
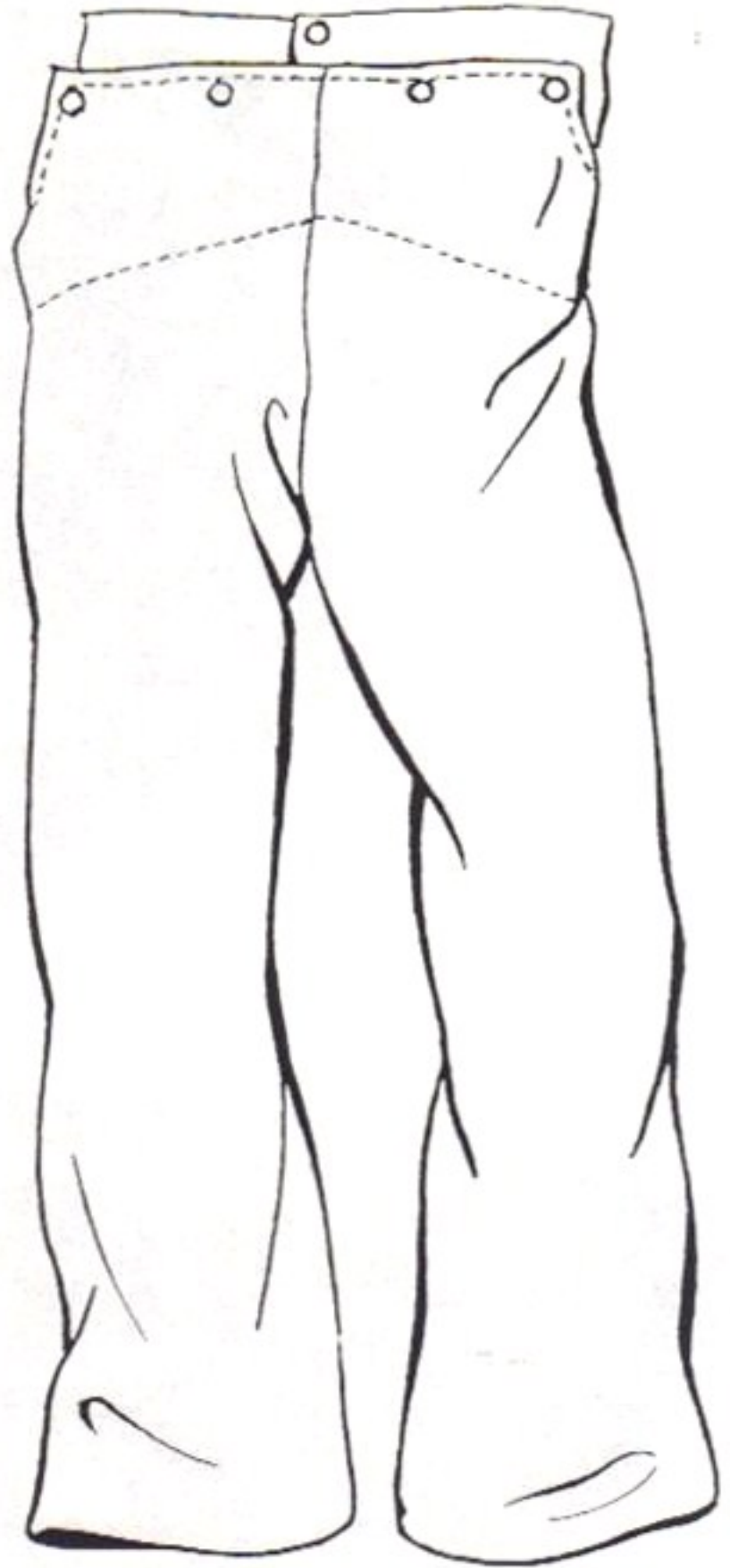

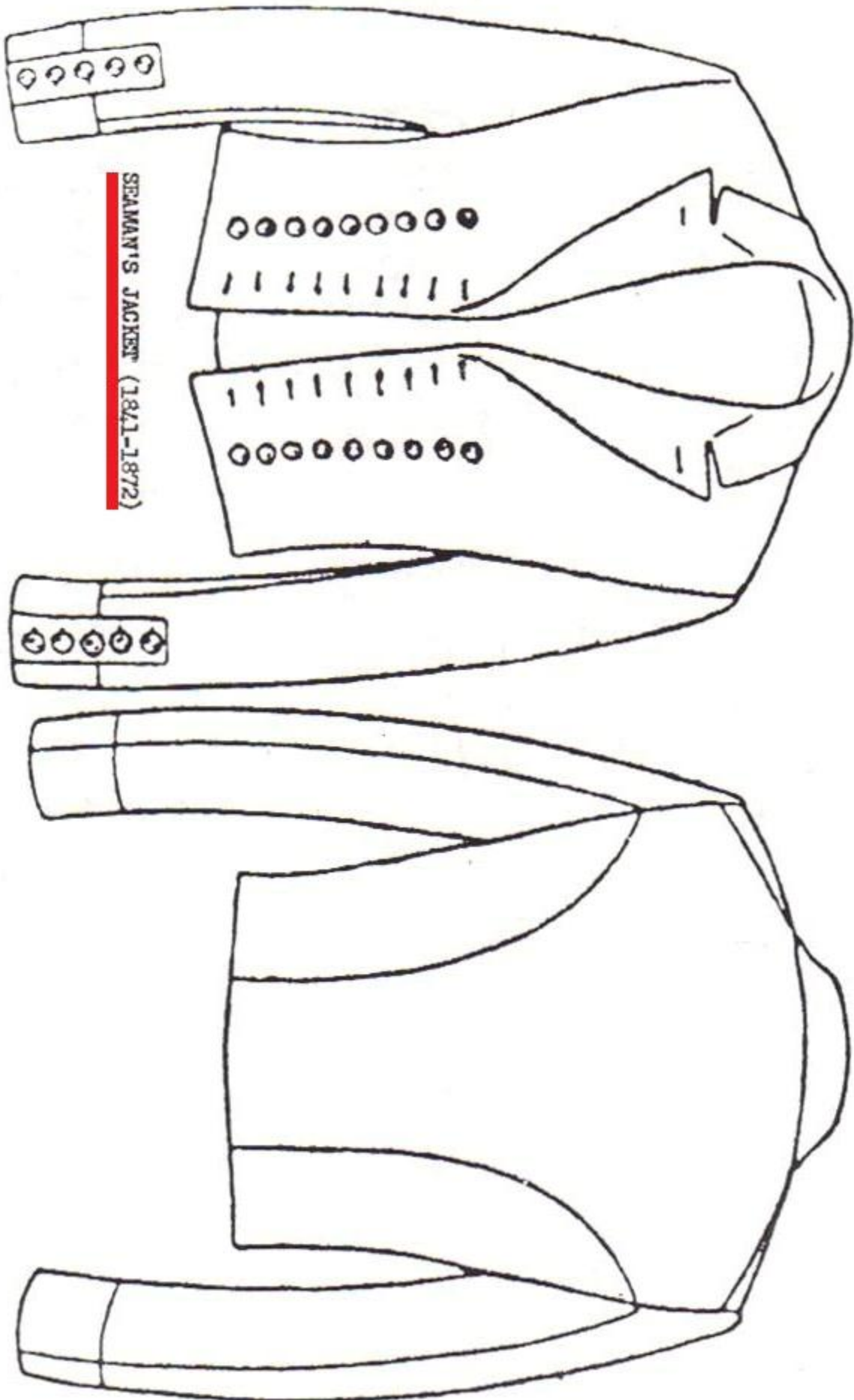
