1 k., k. 2 together, n., and repeat from 2nd round.—2 k., t. t. n., n. 1 st., 1 k., 2 together, t. t. n., 2 and repeat from 9, finally, instead of 2 work only 1 k. 24th rd.—2 k., t. t. n., 1 st. (to do this slip next st., knit off the owing 2 st. together, I drew the slipped st., t. t. n., 2 k., and sat from n., but final instead of 2 k., work t. 2 k., 25th round. All knit plain. Repeat 44 times the 21st rounds, always repeating the design at the curve at the end work 40 inserted mts between the 11th and 12th pattern figures in the middle 24 st., which are taken up on separate needles. Of course the rounds worked on the wrong side should always be purled correspond with the right, and at the end each round the next the st. left standing in the course the inserted rounds should always knit up, so that finally only 24 remain standing. Then continue to work, always going forward, and the 1st round of the 12th pattern are fastened together the middle 8 of the 24 st. previously left standing th 1 st., and after an interval of rounds, before and after these 8 again fasten together 8 st. in a same manner. In the 1st round the 21st pattern figure, above the three narrowings widen 16 st., taking 22 st. on 16 st. there. At the beginning of the 1st round of the 27th and 28th pattern figures, in straight direction above the widening narrow 8 st., fastening them together th 1 st. After finishing the 44th pattern figure, take up the first and last st. on a separate needle for the heel, knit the latter 26 rounds high, and finish in the usual manner. Next take up the edge st. on needles, and knit the st. for the sole all plain, and the st. of the front, which were previously left standing, in the open-work design 40 rounds high, in doing which narrow on both sides of the heel. The toe is worked in 35 rounds, all knit plain in the usual manner.

The stocking Fig. 2 is worked with very soft undyed unbleached knitting cotton, partly with medium-sized steel knitting needles and partly with fine wooden needles, and is perfectly shapeless (without heel, widening, or narrowing), except at the toe, fitting perfectly, nevertheless, by reason of its elasticity. For this stocking work a foundation of the requisite length with the steel needles, knit the edge in a ribbed design of always alternately 2 knit plain

among a class of Episcopals as well as Roman Catholics, will make the accompanying illustrations of value to many of our readers. A few hints concerning materials and colors may also be of service.

Altar covers are usually white or in part of white linen, and may be embroidered with colored cotton or gold thread, and edged with macramé braid or glazed lace. The cover of the pulpit cushion, as well as the pulpit, velum, and burses, may be worked in colored embroidery on canvas, or else in gold embroidery on velvet or silk. The vestments, such as the stole, maniple, chasuble, biret, and roper manile, may be or-

mented in the same manner, chasuble, stole, and maniple matching the pallia, velum, and bures both in material and embroidery. According to ecclesiastical usage, white is used for the feasts sacred to Jesus Christ, the Virgin Mother, the angels, and all saints who did not suffer martyrdom; red for the feast of the Holy Ghost and the martyrs; green is used for the intervals between Pentecost and Advent, and Epiphany and Septuagesima Sunday, but only on days not specially celebrated; blue for Advent, violet for Lent, and black for Good-Friday and funeral services.

Fig. 1.—The stole is a band

worn on the clergyman's shoulders in token of the bonds with which Christ was bound. It is worked on canvas in cross stitch embroidery, in the design one-half of which is given on the embroidery side of the Supplement, with sephyr worsted and filling silk, in the colors specified in the description of symbols. The embroidery is interlined with stiff linen, and lined with silk of the color of the design, and is edged with narrow gold braid.

Fig. 2.—The maniple is a hand worn on the arm, which has the same significance as the stole, and should correspond with the latter. No. 2 of the embroidery side of Supplement gives one-half of the design in cross stitch embroidery.

Figs. 3 and 4.—The chasuble, being the symbol of love, takes the first place among the ecclesiastical vestments, and is worn over all the other garments, falling over the breast and shoulders, in token that

ground down are apt to learn the vices of slaves; and when the Turks slaughtered the men, burnt the villages, and carried off the women, they were ready to return their savage deeds with the like ferocity, and often with more cunning than the Turks could show; and this made the European nations slow of helping them. In this year, 1821, a Greek captain plotted to set fire to the arsenal at Constantinople, murder the Sultan in the confusion, and begin a great revolt of all the Greeks living at Constantinople. The plot was found out, and terribly visited; for thousands of Christian families, who had never even heard of it, were slain in their houses, and the

Patriarch of Constantinople, an aged man, whom every one loved and respected, was also put to death. Not only were the Christians massacred at Constantinople, but in most of the other large cities of Turkey, and only in a few were the people able to escape on board the Greek merchant ships. These ships carried ten or twelve guns, were small, swift, and well managed, and little fire-ships were sometimes sent by them into the Turkish fleet, which did a great deal of damage.




Interior of the Synagogue on Wechslergasse, Lemberg.



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Voici (fig. 2) un chanoine de cette époque¹. Il est vêtu d'une tunique longue rouge, dont on aperçoit le collet et le bas, et d'un large surplis blanc. Sur son bras droit il porte l'aumusse de four-



rure blanche et grise ; son bonnet est violet. C'est à dater de la fin du xv^e siècle que les manches du surplis sont souvent fendues des épaules à la saignée, afin de les pouvoir laisser flotter par derrière. Le nom latin *superpellicium* indique que, dans l'origine, cette longue tunique de lin, blanche, était posée par-dessus la pelice ou
